The Lyle Jamieson demonstration was held at the Woodcraft store in Peoria on Saturday, August 3.

Lyle gave us some background information about himself, and said he has only been turning in earnest for about twelve years.

He discussed, at some length, proper mounting of the blank. He felt it was very important to properly support the lathe and to mount the blank properly in order to keep vibration to a minimum.

Everyone was invited to turn with the Ellsworth gouge as Lyle looked on. He also touched on the Ellsworth sharpening jig and its use.

Lyle showed some photos of his well known torsos and discussed his technique.

It was a full day of interesting turning.
