**Dave Bloom**---bowls from paela, bubinga, muhuhu, red heart, silver maple and sassafras burl; **Keith Adams**---bowl from red oak burl and a hollow turning from walnut overgrowth; **Wilson Banks**---bowls turned from oak burl and cherry; **Paul Cobb**---cherry bowl and a cherry and walnut segmented bowl; **Dick Coers**---natural edge bowl from hard maple and Christmas ornaments; **Ron Bell**---natural edge bowl from sourwood; **Dwight Crane**---oak bowl (end grain turning).
