Show-N-Tell

T. Quiram---walnut bowl, bowl from apple wood, threaded box from cherry. **D. Coers**---pine bowl, laminated veneers and an ornament turned from it, Dakota burl and a pen turned from it. **D. Bloom**---walnut bowls, cherry bowls, bottle stoppers. **W. Banks**---rough turned bowl from redbud, walnut natural edge bowl. **K. Adams**---hard maple plywood turnings and large bowls from spalted wood, one natural and one colored. **D. Crane**---tall colored vessels, colored natural edge bowl, natural edge bowl from olive wood. **R. Waller**---walnut candlestick holder and big pencil. **K. Zimmerman**---bowl from ash, natural edge walnut bowl and potpourri bowl. **B. Adam**---bowl from Norfolk Island pine and closed vessel from cherry (Arrowmont projects). **J. Sievers**---goblet and natural edge mulberry bowl.
